***Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield***

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met March 11, 2020 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Present: Supervisor Gary Budd, Trustees, Shannon Lynch, Don Willett, Mike Morris, Arthur Watts, Clerk Robert Remack, Road Commissioner Ron Smith, Assessor Cinda Sausaman, Collector Janine Stroble.

**Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.**

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of February 12, 2020 were reviewed. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. Included in the bills are checks in amount of \$571.20 to Goodyear Tire, \$84.84 to Village of Grandview, \$40.50 to Elmo Products, and \$230.00 to Henson Robinson Heating. A motion was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Mike Morris that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Collector Janine Stroble said the intergovernmental agreement between Capital Township and Springfield Township signed last year was good for three years. She said her office will start collecting taxes the first or second week in May.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** \$110.00 was collected from the dumpster program this month.

Supervisor Gary Budd reported he met with Senator Brady to discuss the 32<sup>nd</sup> St./ Ridgewood Ave. Water Project. Senator Brady said residents would have to pay 50% of \$210,000.00 upfront. Letter have been sent out to residents. He said he also met with Brian Smith with TOI and Brian told him to avoid state funding and try to obtain federal funding instead.

The Board reviewed the 2020-2021 Town & Road District Budgets. Supervisor Gary Budd said only minor changes have been made to the estimates. He said the board should vote on the budgets at the April regular board meeting.

**NEW BUSINESS:** A motion was made Shannon Lynch and seconded by Arthur watts to approve the 2020-2021 board meeting schedule. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to approve the annual town meeting agenda. Discussion of a federal water grant was added. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Township Officials were reminded to file their Economic Interest Statements by May 1<sup>st</sup>.

The Board discussed costs associated with an electronic recycling event. They are reviewing pricing submitted by CJD E-Recycling. Will discuss further and hopes to vote on it at April board meeting.

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Grandview Village President Pete Ochs reported the City of Springfield and Village of Grandview are considering annexing the Village into the City. Supervisor Gary Budd said he will be attending the next Village Board Meeting.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Shannon Lynch. All voted aye. Motion carried.
