**Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.**

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of May 13, 2020 were reviewed. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to authorize board pre-approval of operating expenses for the next year. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Upon the advice of Attorney Don LoBue, a motion was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Mike Morris to postpone the 2020 Annual Town Meeting until the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the month following the expiration of the disaster proclamation issued by the Governor. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Shannon Lynch. All voted aye. Motion carried.
