***Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield***

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met September 09th, 2020 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Present: Supervisor Gary Budd, Trustees Shannon Lynch, Don Willett, Mike Morris, Arthur Watts, Clerk Robert Remack, Collector Janine Stroble, Assessor Cinda Sausaman. Excused: Road Commissioner Ron Smith.

**Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.**

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of August 12, 2020 were reviewed. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Arthur Watts that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** \$170.00 to \$180.00 was collected from the dumpster program on the first Saturday of the month. \$1,010.00 was deposited in September.

Supervisor Gary Budd said the township is waiting on response from the IL. Dept. of Public Health regarding the 32nd St Ridgewood Ave. water project.

Collector Janine Stroble reported the property taxes are due September 11th. Penalties will apply if paid after this date.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Supervisor Gary Budd discussed the complaint made by individual from Calvary Cemetery regarding the installation of culvert on 1<sup>st</sup> Street. He said the work was approved by the Sangamon County Highway Dept.

A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Shannon Lynch to approve the audit draft for year ending March 31,2020 with 2 exceptions noted, raises are to be in writing and record should be kept of receipts and expenses of the dumpster program. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Supervisor Gary Budd said he is not in favor of giving raises for the next term at this time. However, request for raises should be submitted to him and the Board will vote on setting salaries next month.

He also reported the township has applied for \$20,000.00 covid-19 reimbursement.

**GENERAL TOWN REPORT BY SUPERVISOR:** Gary Budd said he attended the Village of Grandview Board Meeting last Tuesday night. New Mayor Rick Larson was appointed in June. Said they discussed annexation, nuisance properties, dumpster program and newsletter.

He reported Camp Sangamo Road reconstruction is in the hands of the County. Motor Fuel Tax is paying for the \$90,000.00 project and work has to be done by September 30<sup>th</sup>.

The Road District has collected a little over \$2,000.00 from selling iron while prices are up to \$100.00 a ton. Still have 4 to 6 loads to sell.

**COMMENTS & ITEMS OF PUBLIC CONCERN:** Present was Village of Grandview Mayor Rick Larson. He said the Village has tabled the annexation of Grandview into Springfield as most residents he spoke with oppose annexation. He said the Village has made some positive changes recently including hiring a couple more police officers and he is looking forward to working with the Township Board.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Shannon Lynch. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
